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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

As always, it is a pleasure for me to highlight recent accomplishments of the CWRU-MetroHealth System *Center for Health Care Research and Policy*. During 2010-11, the Center strengthened partnerships in multidisciplinary research and training and increased both its community impact and national visibility. Faculty research was recognized by over \$5.7 million in grants during 2011 as well as awards for high impact publications, elected positions to state and national posts in quality and delivery system reform, and recognition for excellence in the meaningful use of health information technology. Collectively, 27 core Center faculty and Senior Scholars published over 170 papers of their scholarly work, including many that were jointly authored with other Center faculty and our students and post-graduate trainees. USING GREATER CLEVELAND AS A LIVING LABORATORY.

Center faculty have long recognized the health-related challenges of northeast Ohio as common to many urban areas in the United States and viewed the region as a living laboratory to study and improve population health and health care. Two illustrations of this commitment and approach are described below.

Reducing Pre-term Deliveries. An excellent example of using northeast Ohio as a living laboratory for improvement is the longstanding work of Associate Professor and Center Senior Scholar Jennifer Bailit, MD, MPH. As Director of Labor and Delivery and Perinatal Care at MetroHealth, Jennifer's passion to reduce the frequency of pre-term deliveries comes from personal experience in caring for mothers and their fragile newborns who too frequently suffer potentially avoidable complications. One approach to prevent pre-term

births, Dr. Bailit believed, was to increase the use of an effective but overly expensive "orphan" drug ("17P") for expectant mothers who had experienced previous premature births. Together with Mark Votruba, PhD, Director of the Center's Health Economics Unit, Dr. Bailit published an award-winning economic analysis of the drug in 2007, which drew not only scholarly acclaim but the attention of U.S. Senator Sherrod Brown. Following a 2011 press conference with Dr. Bailit and others at MetroHealth, Senator Brown embarked on a personal crusade that led the drug company to reduce the medication's cost by over half. In a complementary state-wide effort funded by the NIH, Dr. Bailit and her colleagues sought to reduce "convenience" deliveries before 39 weeks of gestation, resulting in a 60% reduction in early induced labors that were due to ill-

informed patient or physician preference. Her passion and the effectiveness of the state-wide work were featured in the March, 2012 "Best Docs" issue of *Cleveland Magazine*.

Improving the Health of Adults with Chronic Conditions. Another example of using Greater Cleveland as a living laboratory is the work of my physician colleagues throughout the region to measure and improve the health outcomes of their patients with chronic medical conditions. Catalyzed by data sharing and twice yearly regional quality improvement summits, *Better Health Greater Cleveland* has drawn national attention for its innovative use and documented benefits of electronic health records (EHRs). In September 2011, *Better Health's* leaders published findings in the *New England Journal of Medicine* that demonstrated that diabetic patients cared for in practices using EHRs achieved much better results, and improved much faster over a three-year period, than did patients in paper-based clinical practices. Described by *The Health Care Blog* as a publication "that could become a seminal piece in support of the current administration's efforts to reform the healthcare sector," the publication already has been recognized twice as among the most impactful health research papers of 2011. Indeed, results in the paper motivated a visit and press conference in Cleveland last November by U.S. Secretary of Health and Human Services Kathleen Sibelius and National Coordinator of Health Information Technology Dr. Farzad Mostashari.

Perhaps as important to *Better Health's* success is the remarkable collaboration among physicians from competing health care organizations. This is due largely to the leadership and trust engendered by faculty and data management skills of *Better Health* personnel in the Center, including director of *Better Health's* Data Management Center and Director of the Center's Biostatistics and Evaluation Unit, Thomas Love, Ph.D.

EXPANDING OUR REACH

Through community service, publications and presentations, our faculty expanded its impact throughout the U.S. in 2010-11. We both learned from and shared our successes with numerous scholars and policymakers nationwide at the Center's Health Service Research seminars and public forums (see table on next page), supported both by grants and endowments.

that five physician investigators again have been named among “Best Doctors in America”, reflecting their dual talents and passions for research and patient care. The election of two faculty members to positions on Committees of the National Quality Forum also reflect both their national recognition and their commitments to measuring and improving quality in their respective disciplines. Finally, recognition of the region’s innovative applications of EHRs to patient care was recognized not only by awards for the *New England Journal of Medicine* publication, described earlier. Cleveland also was the only 2011 double award winner for excellence in applied informatics by the Association of Medical Directors of Information Services - one to The MetroHealth System and a second to its Chief Medical Information Office, Associate Professor and Center Senior Scholar David Kaelber.

COMMENT

Despite strong forces in the health care market and continuing challenges to the region's economy, Center faculty continue to serve leadership roles in region-wide collaborations that serve as national models for other health care markets and multidisciplinary research initiatives. In no small way, our ability to undertake these initiatives reflects strong leadership of the CWRU School of Medicine and the ongoing commitment of The MetroHealth System to scholarship and improving the health of the public in Greater Cleveland. We continue to be grateful for their support.
